



## Role Profile – Wrap Around Coordinators

### Role Overview

We are currently looking for a number of Wrap Around Coordinators to assist with the delivery of the [Autism Central](#) South West Regional Hub. Autism Central offers families and carers of autistic people high quality and easily accessible autism education, training and support through peer educators, alongside a dedicated website. Peer educators are autistic people, and parents and carers of autistic people, who have been trained to support other families. Bristol Autism Support is delivering Autism Central in the South West NHS England Region.

The aims of Wrap Around Coordinators is to deliver 1-1 sessions with family carers with a particular focus on:

- Those in crisis
- Underrepresented communities
- Those who have additional barriers to accessing education and support

The role will include:

- Provision of 1-1 support to families and carers of autistic individuals, this can be in person, online or via phone.
- Follow up administration including key performance indicator monitoring
- Focus on a geographical area in the South West and support provision to peer educators in this area
- Professional development support to peer educators and hub team.
- Support to keep hub portal information up to date and relevant

The role is being offered on a part time basis of 8-24 hours per week in term time at £25 per hour (set hours to be agreed based on availability). All Wrap Around Co-ordinators will be required to complete the programme's national tier 2 training. It is expected that the role will be mostly delivered virtually (online / phone support).

What we are looking for

Candidates are required to be a family member, partner / spouse, carer or personal assistant of an autistic person or an autistic person. Candidates must have a good understanding of autism and peer support experience. Knowledge of safeguarding. Knowledge of relevant laws (equality act 2010 / SEND code of practice).

Applicants must live within the South West NHS England Region and be motivated with an ability to learn and support families and carers. Enhanced [DBS checks](#) will be required for this role.
